

## SUPPLIES

20"-22" **Bandana** ,18" panel to adhere the bandana to, **Mod Podge – MATTE** , [you will need a 2 oz. bottle for the bandana] **Craft clamps** or clothes pins [used to keep bandana in place while gluing] , **Ruler**, **Old brush** to apply Mod Podge, **Water**, **Sponge**, possibly **Gloves** if you don't like it on your hands.

To paint the design, I used brushes from my everyday collection which include various size angled flats, rounds for base coating, fine liners and detail brushes and possibly a mop.

The pattern is sized for a 20" -22" Fabric bandana. **You can change the size and paint in on any other fabric print you prefer or eliminate the fabric all together and paint the design on any surface.** Mine is a Masonite panel- Foam core may be used but I find it warps so you must use a lot of weight on it or secure it in a frame. If your Masonite or panel is not white already, spray or paint it with flat white primer. If you don't do this -the dark Masonite may show through light parts of the bandana design or fabric. Bandanas are available at craft stores like Michael's and Hobby Lobby, Walmart, and Amazon. Make sure you open it up to see the design. The borders and the design space in the center vary. Some are square centers and some are round. Choose whatever will fit your design.
